I can also do that.

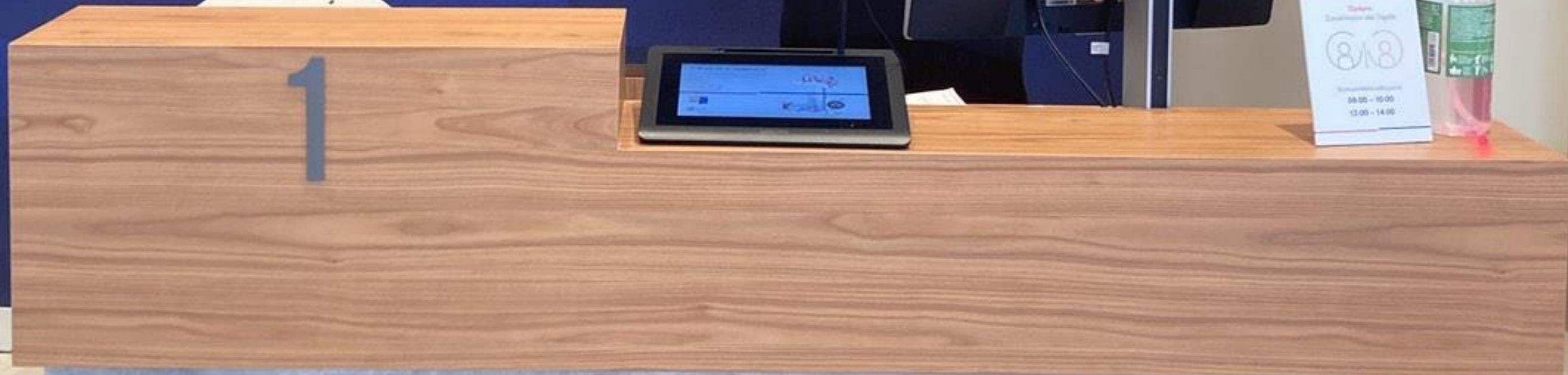
There is also a small screen on the wall of the reception area.
